For the Players

Our tournament offers both morning and afternoon rounds. Players and/or teams may play 18 or 36 holes.

COURSE PRIZES INCLUDE:

- Closest to the pin on all Par 3's
- Most accurate drive
- \$500 for any tee shot that ends up within 6 inches of the cup
- A new car for any hole-in-one (all Par 3's)

All course prizes, with the exception of Par 3 hole-in-one prize(s), will be awarded to the morning and afternoon rounds.

Par 3 hole-in-one prizes will be awarded once to the first player to score a hole-in-one on the designated prize hole for the day.

The putting contest hole-in-one prize is available once in each round and will be determined with an additional putt in the event of multiple hole-in-one's in the same round.

NON-COURSE PRIZES INCLUDE:

- Putting contest (play at the turn, no charge)
- Door prizes (by drawing at turn, no charge)

GOODY BAG:

Each player who has paid his/her registration will receive a goody bag. Players who play both morning and afternoon rounds will receive a goody bag for each round.

FOUR-MAN SWAT:

Players may form their own teams, or the tournament committee will form one for you.

DOOR PRIZES:

Door prizes will be awarded by drawing at the putting contest area as the golfers make the turn. Other prizes will be awarded at the award ceremonies.

TROPHIES:

Trophies will be awarded for 1st and 2nd place teams in each flight. The number of flights will be determined by the number of players. Trophies will be awarded for both the morning and afternoon rounds.

COST:

- \$225 per player (morning or afternoon round)
- \$450 for players playing both rounds
